

Risk Assessment Policy

Farley Cricket Club

- The Club's Risk Assessment Schedule details the assessments that must be carried out periodically throughout a season, together with the person(s) responsible. The Club's committee is responsible for reviewing this Schedule and ensuring its completion.
- Risk Assessment Forms must be completed prior to any junior activity, be that a practice session or a match (home and away). The completion of a Risk Assessment Form is the responsibility of a designated Club coach (practice session) or team manager (match).
- Completed Risk Assessment Forms must be retained and passed to the Club's Child Welfare Officer or Youth Team Manager, who will discuss any items highlighted on the form and agree any action to be taken.
- The Club requires all Club coaches to be members of the ECB Coaches Association.
